Non-Renewable Energy


- Many Governments do not want to knock down old power plants and old dams that do not produce electricity.


Non-Renewable Energy

- Thus if we do nothing the use of nonrenewable energy will not disappear any time soon.


- The devastating environmental affects cannot be avoided with current levels of investment.
